# Summer 2017 Social Skills Camps

*with Christine Jurik, MA, BCBA, COBA*

## Social Explorers (ages 4-6) | Sat. 8:45 - 10:15 a.m.

Participants will learn how to follow multiple-step group instructions, share, take turns, begin to identify emotions in self/others, and express their wants and needs effectively with peers.

## Superheroes (ages 7-9) | Sat. 10:30 a.m. - noon

Participants will learn how to engage in and sustain conversational exchanges, choose appropriate topics, remain on topic, know what to do when they witness bullying, demonstrate cooperation, and learn how to use self-regulation techniques when peers do not do what they desire during group activities.

## The Crew (ages 10-13) | Sat. 12:15 - 1:45 p.m.

Participants will rehearse how to engage in and sustain age-appropriate conversational exchanges utilizing appropriate topics, remain on topic, know what to do when they witness bullying, share with fellow peers personal social struggles in order to feel less alone, and receive peer advice on slight changes they can make to create more successful social interactions in school and other settings.

## Cost, Services Provided, and Schedule

Group cost is \$600 per student and includes a 30-minute 1:1 intake with the Behavior Analyst, individualized goal development, eight 90-minute small group sessions, take-home worksheets from the Social Thinking™ curriculum, and performance updates.

These small-group therapy sessions will begin on June 10 and end August 12. There will be no sessions on June 24 or July 1. Wednesday afternoon/evening dates are also available. Please call or email for details.
